CONTAINERS

All garbage, trash and other waste shall be placed in containers which shall be concealed and contained within buildings or shall be concealed by means of a screening wall of material similar to and compatible with that of the building on the Lot or shall be concealed by sufficient landscaping to provide a permanent screen at all times of the year. (Per the deed restrictions)

SNOW

When there is **snow**: Residents are responsible for clearing their driveway, the sidewalk in front of their home, and their mailbox. (Per Orange Township)
